

## Five Ways to Stay Safe When Working on Chassis in Marine Terminals

**1**

**Be aware of vehicle traffic patterns and conduct work in a protected area.**

**2**


**Disconnect and secure chassis from semi-tractors before performing maintenance or repairs.**

**3**

**Never position yourself under a jacked vehicle or equipment.**

**4**

**Follow safety procedures for bleeding pressure from charged brake cylinders before performing work or removing them.**

**5**

**Service single- and multi-piece rim wheels according to 29 CFR 1910.177 and 1917.44.**
